

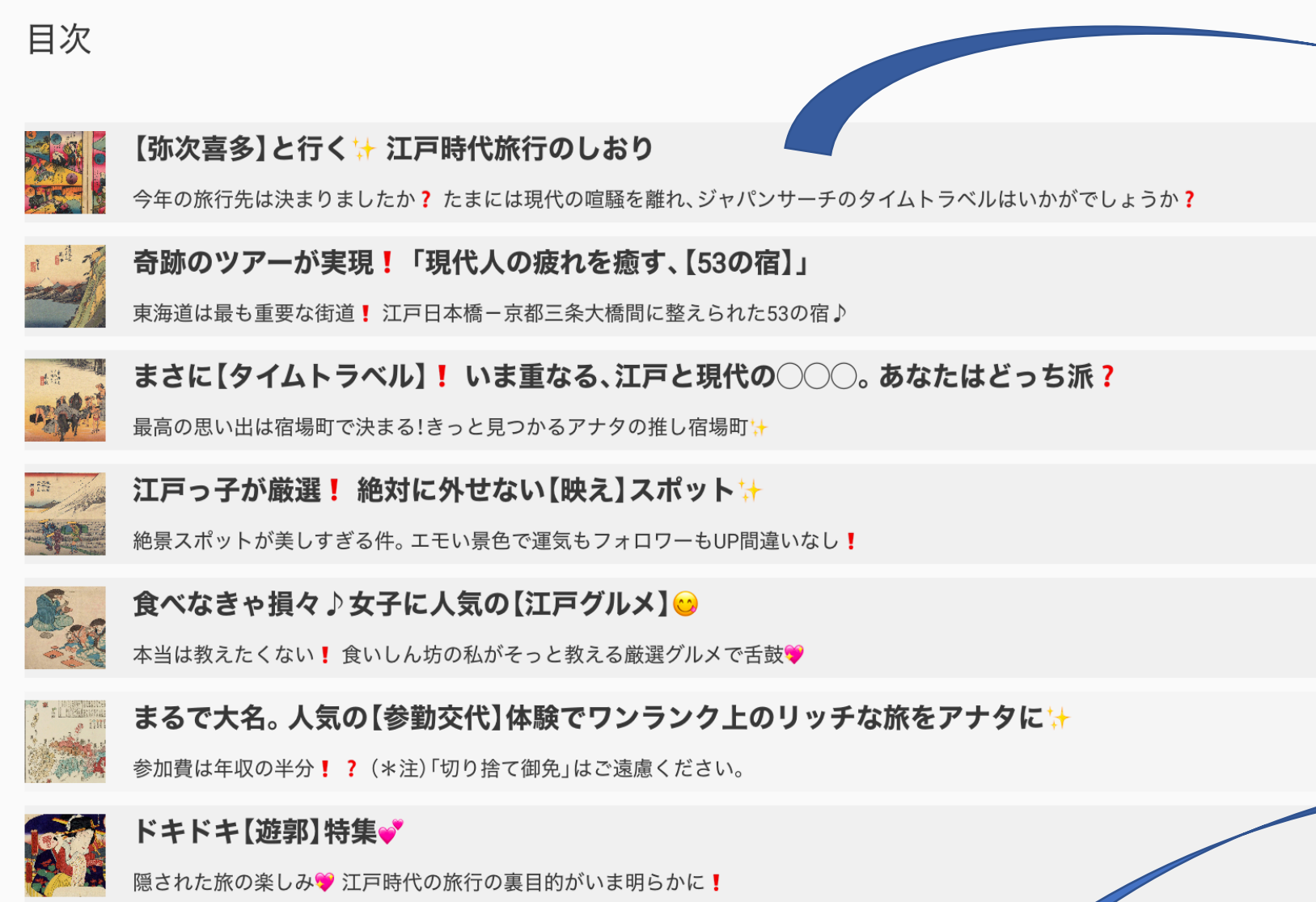

Promote educational use of MLA digital archives

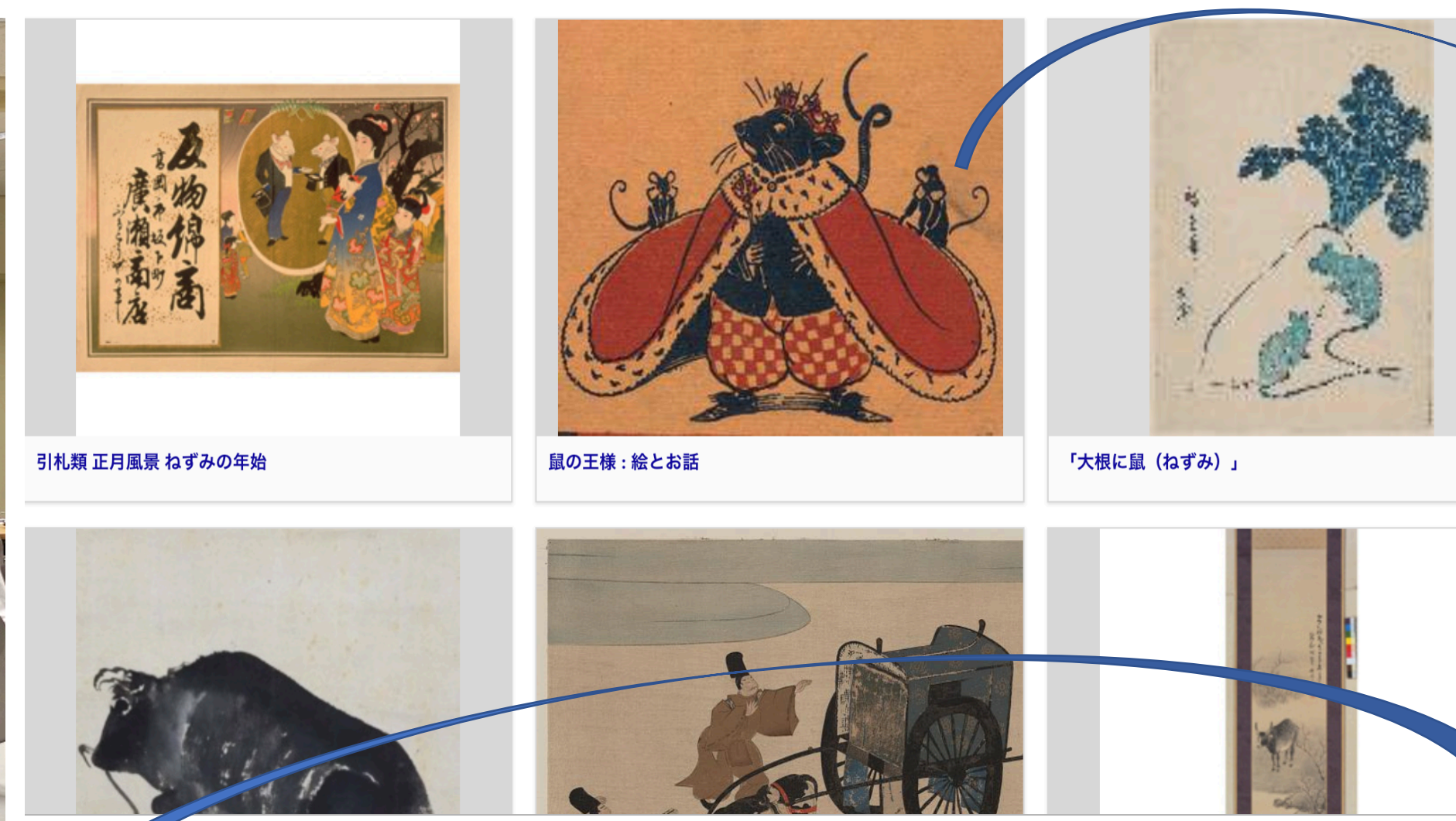

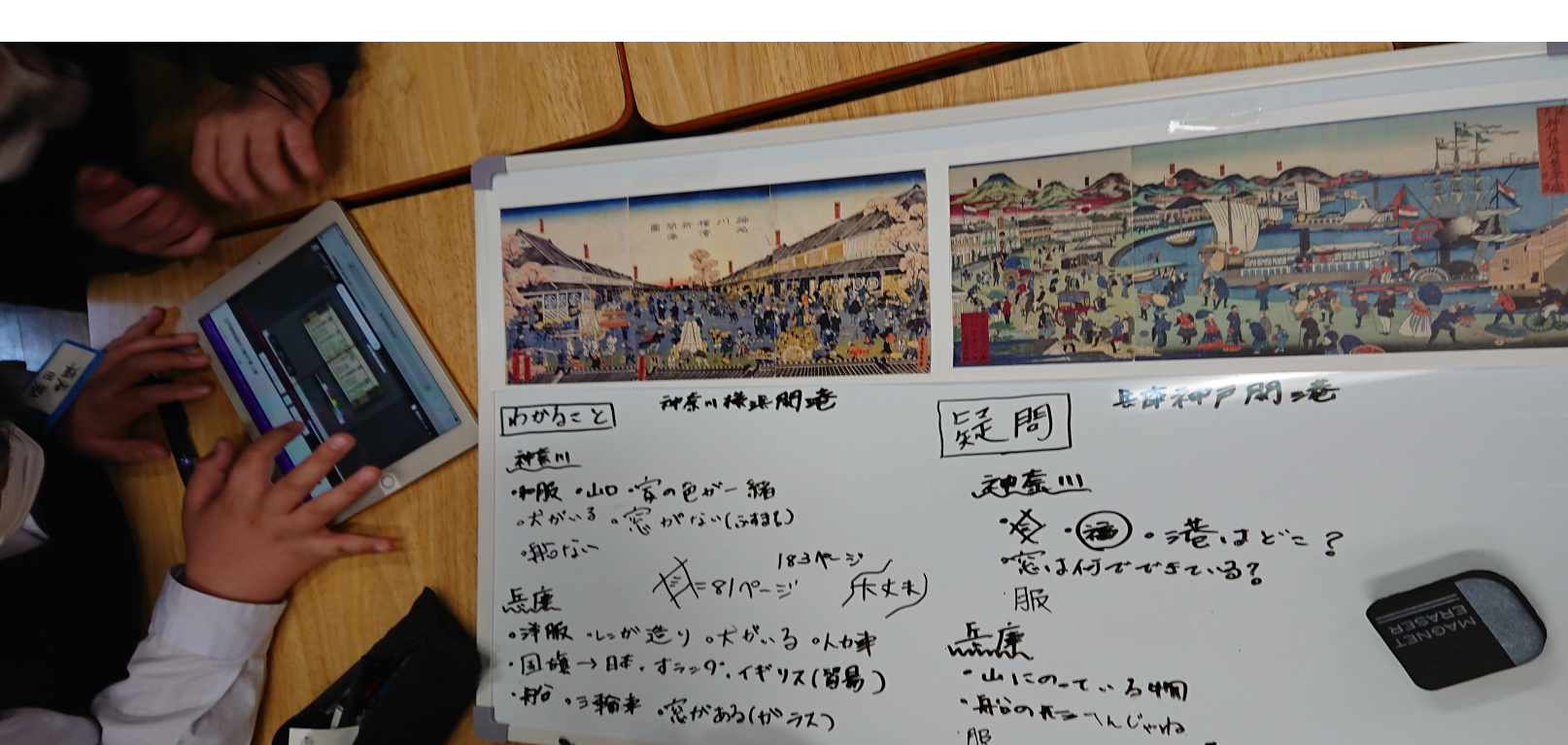
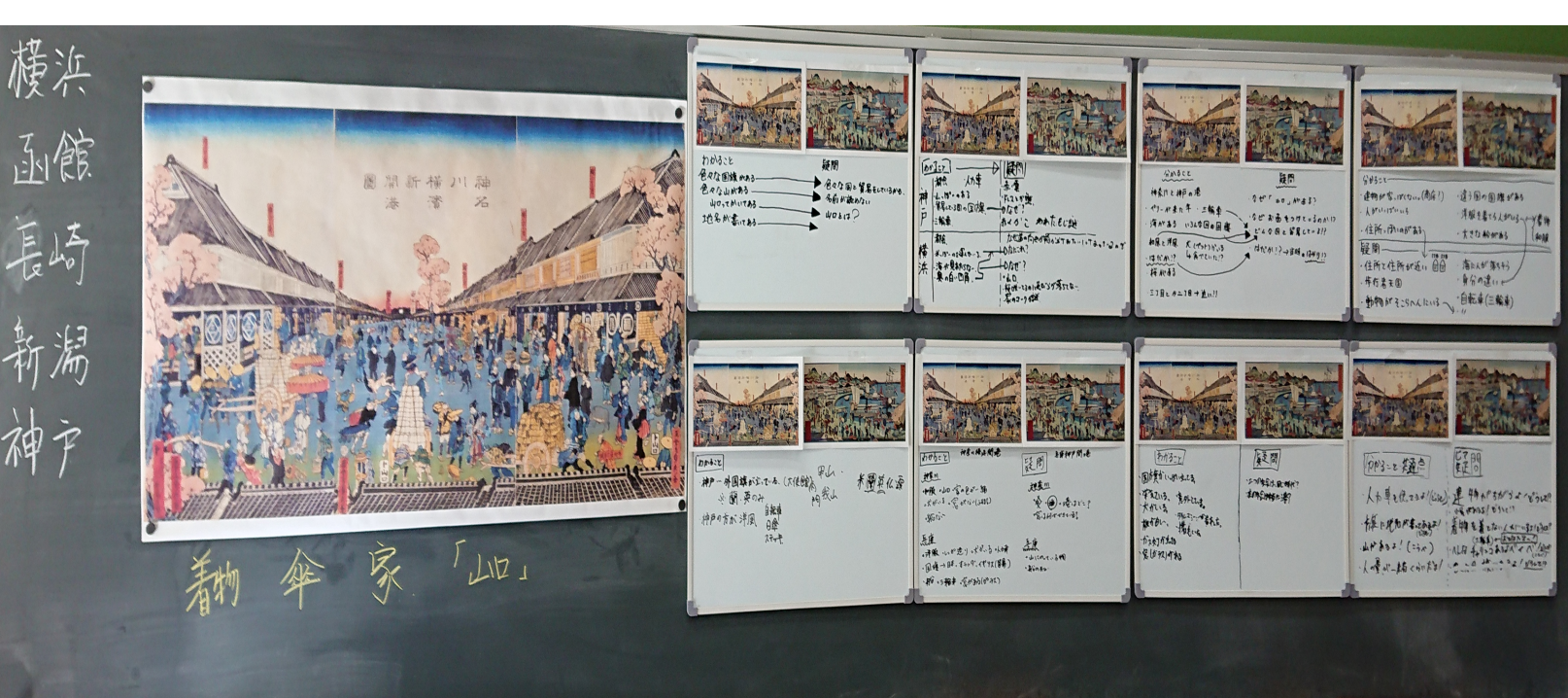
【concept】 For Educational Practice

【Purpose】 Implementation of functions that can be curated **collaboratively**

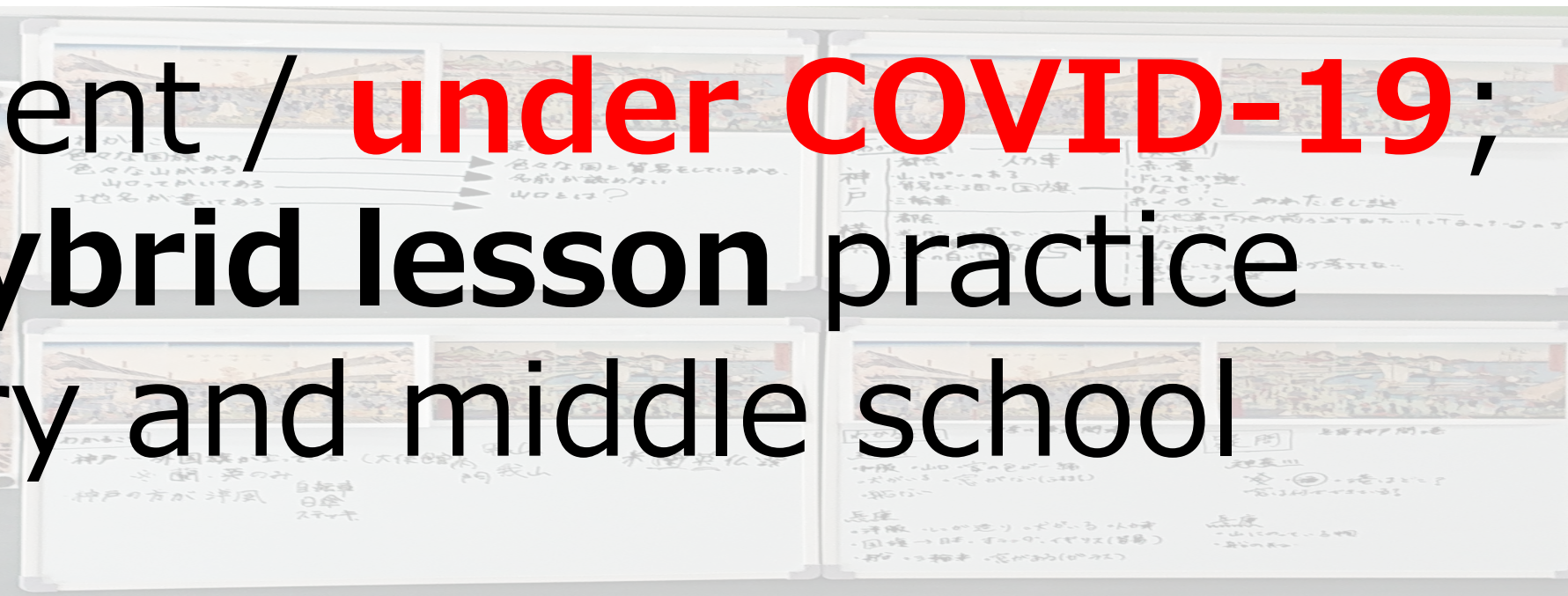
## ⑤ Practice in elementary, Junior high school, high school (2020-February)

【Class theme】 : Various histories that can be seen as "connecting" by collecting multiple materials from digital archives

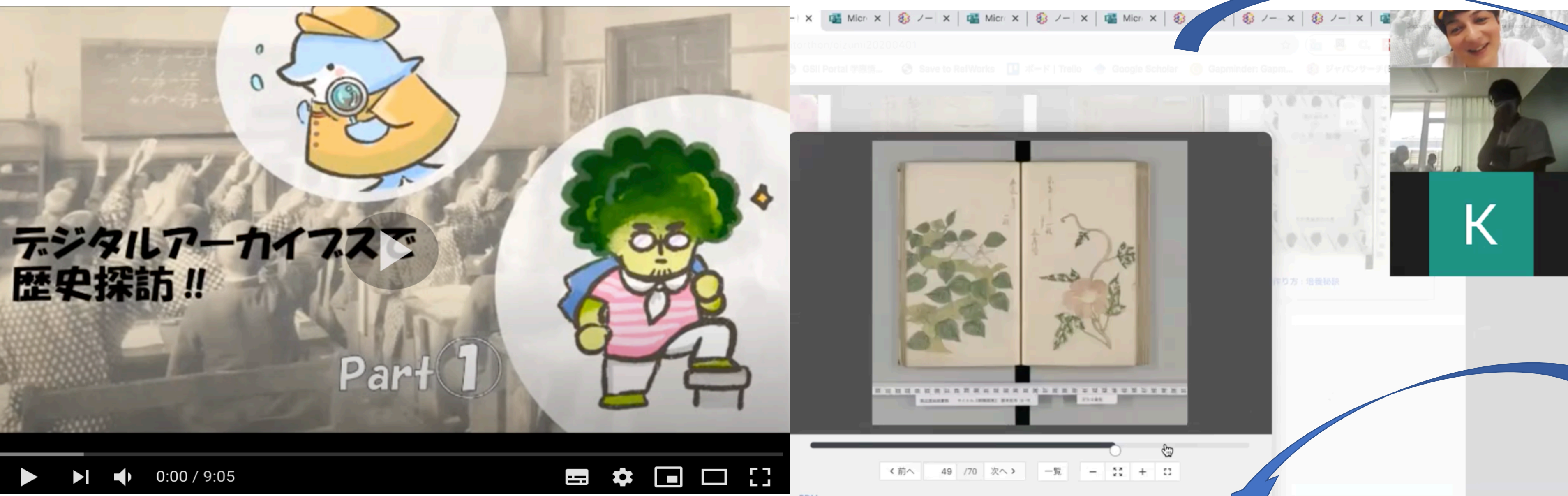


## ⑥ April 2020-present / **under COVID-19**; **Long-term hybrid lesson** practice in elementary and middle school

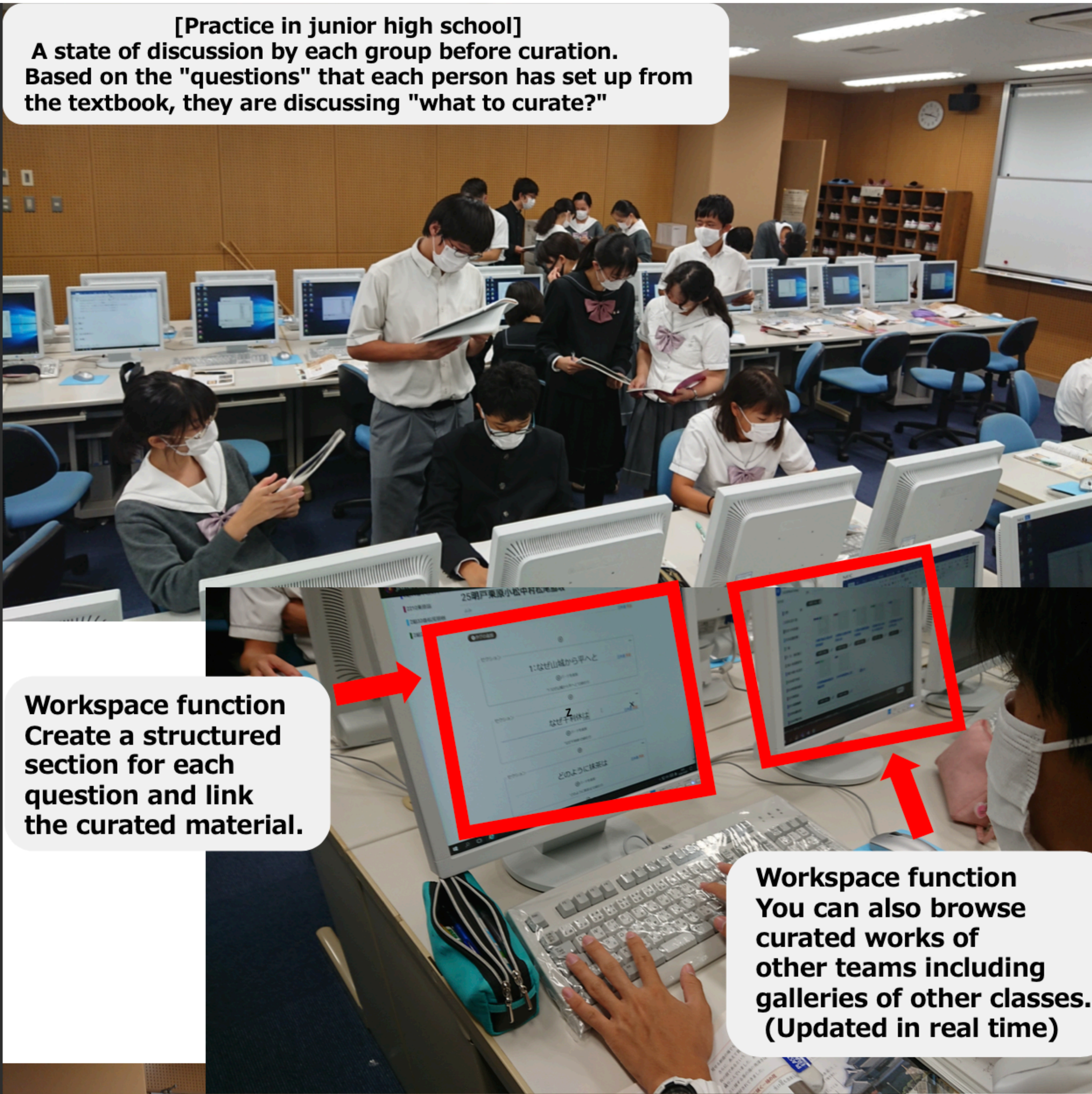

"Work space" new function



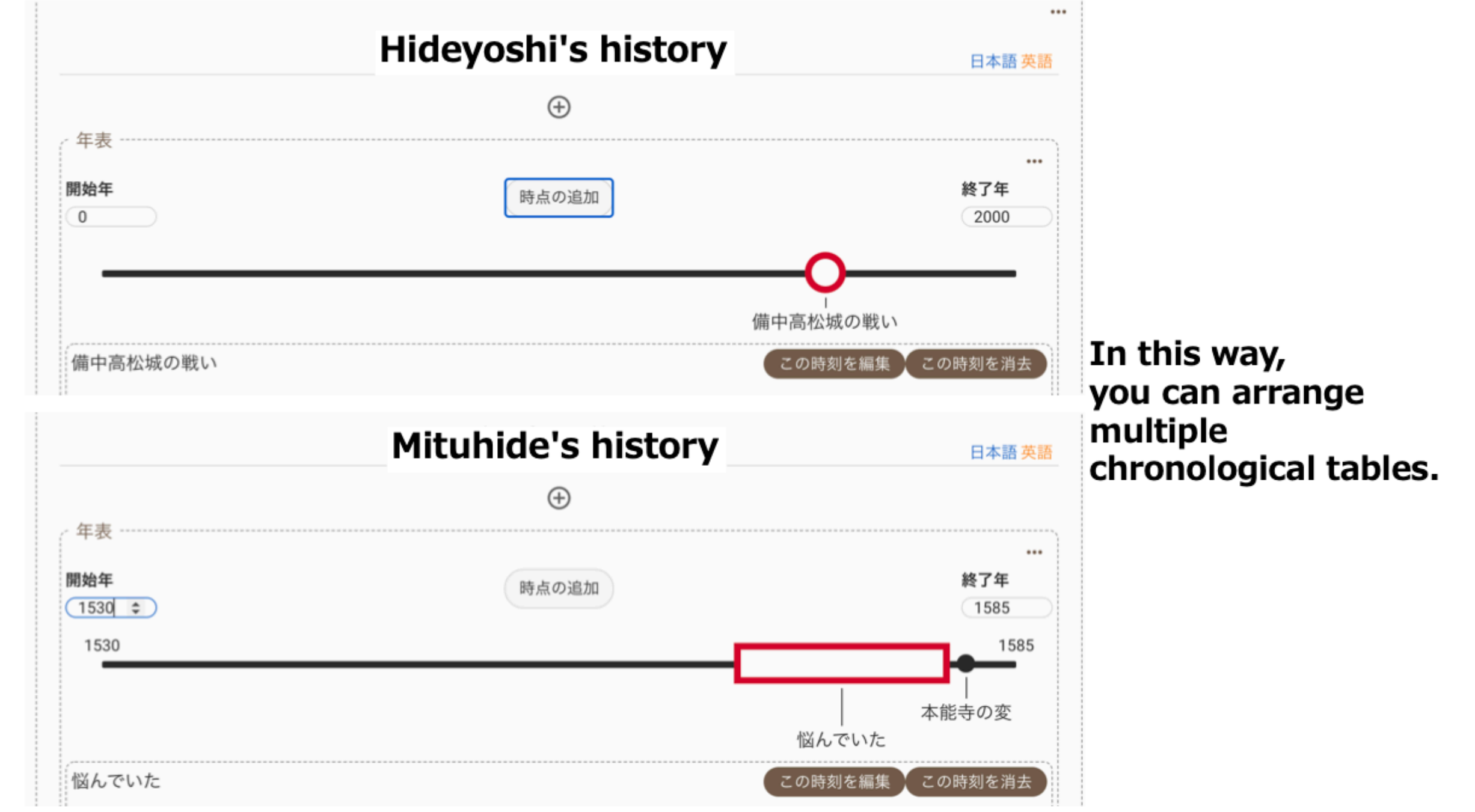
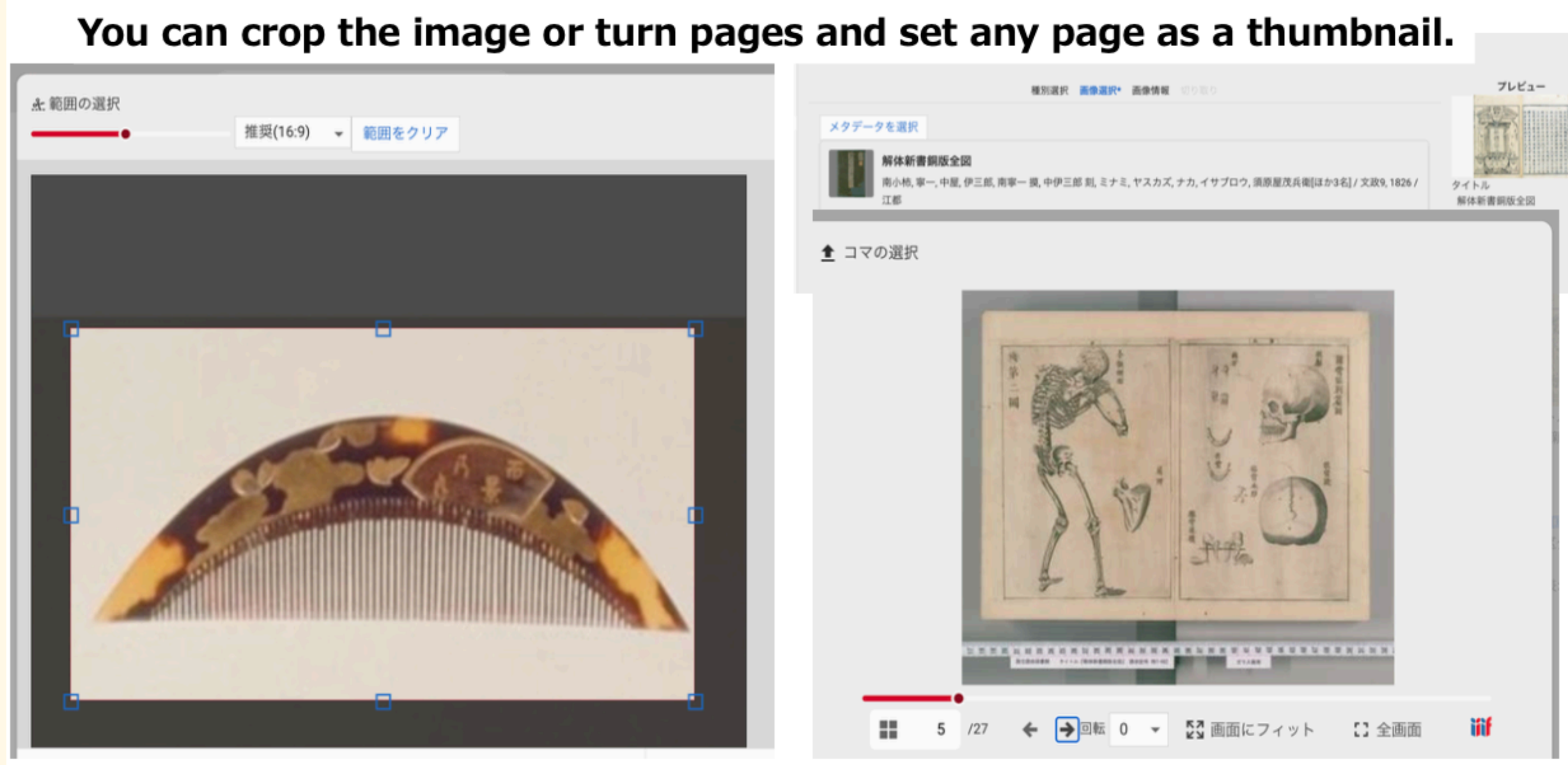
⑧ Practice in elementary, Junior high school (2020-April~)

Based on the "questions" that each person has set up from the textbook, they are discussing "what to curate?"

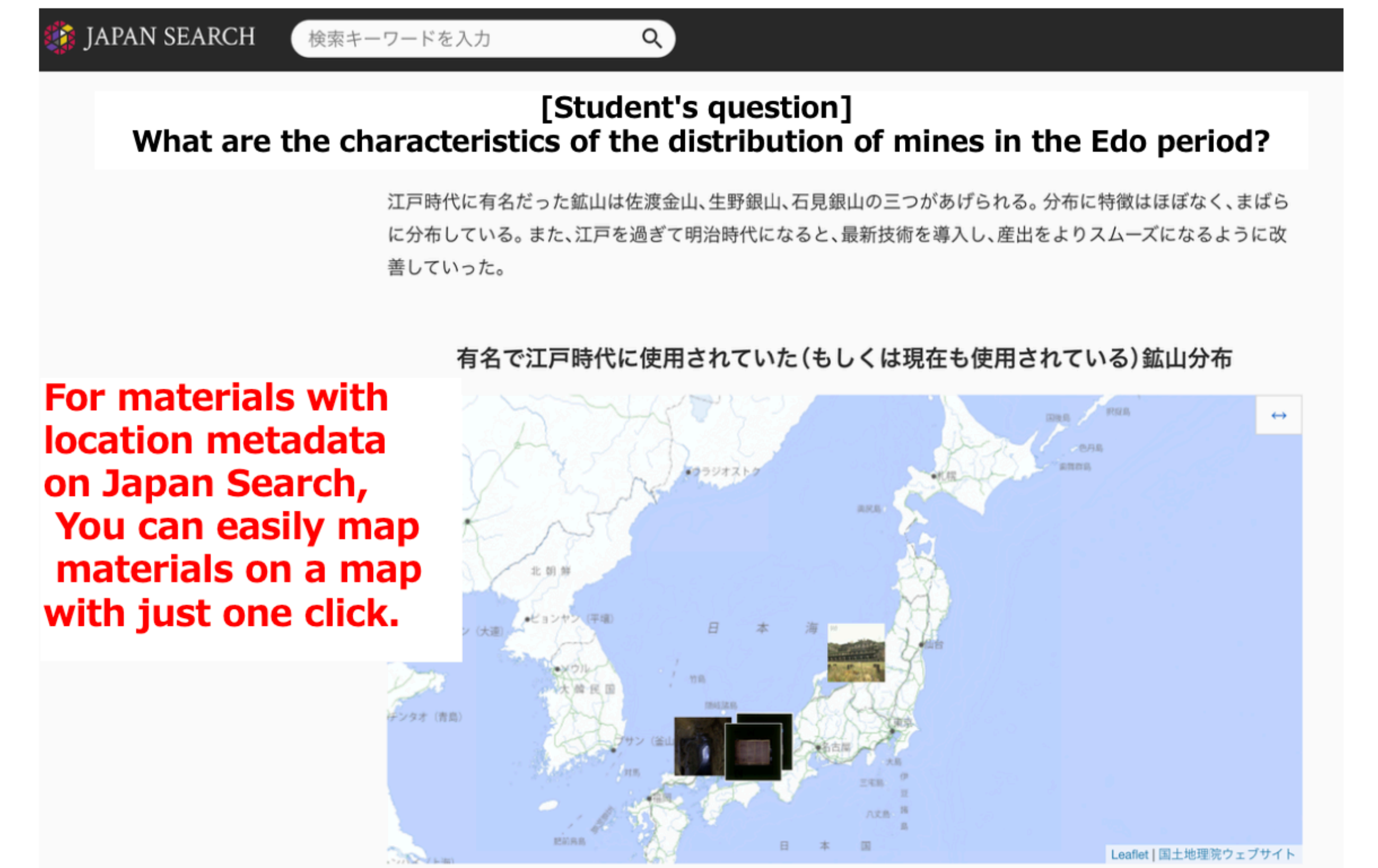


Workspace function

【 Points of interest in "curation learning" in this research 】

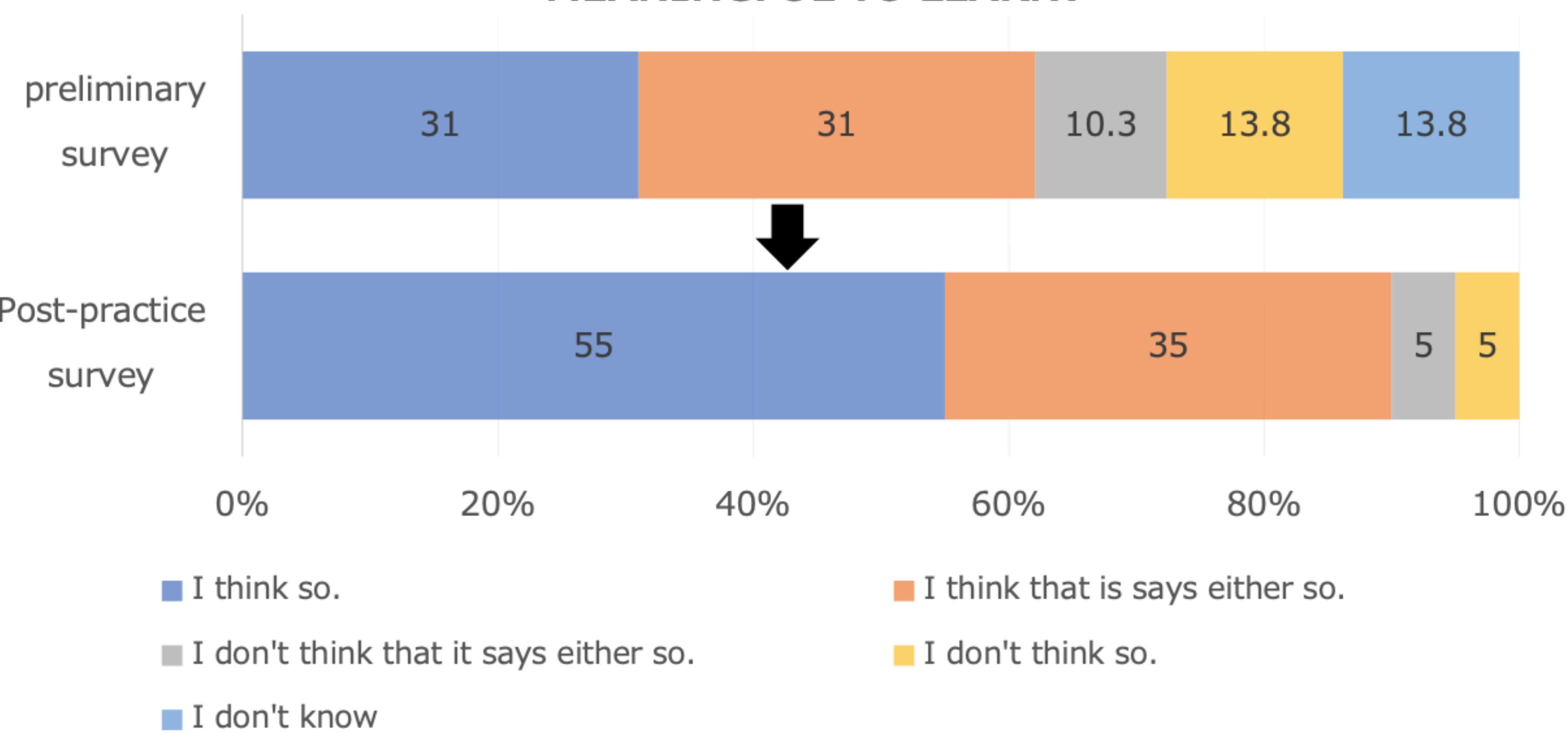
- It can be seen that the questions posed from the same textbook are **expanding** learning to **various fields** depending on the students.
- Digital cultural resources and MLA materials are **linked as evidence** to the inquiry learning of each student's question.



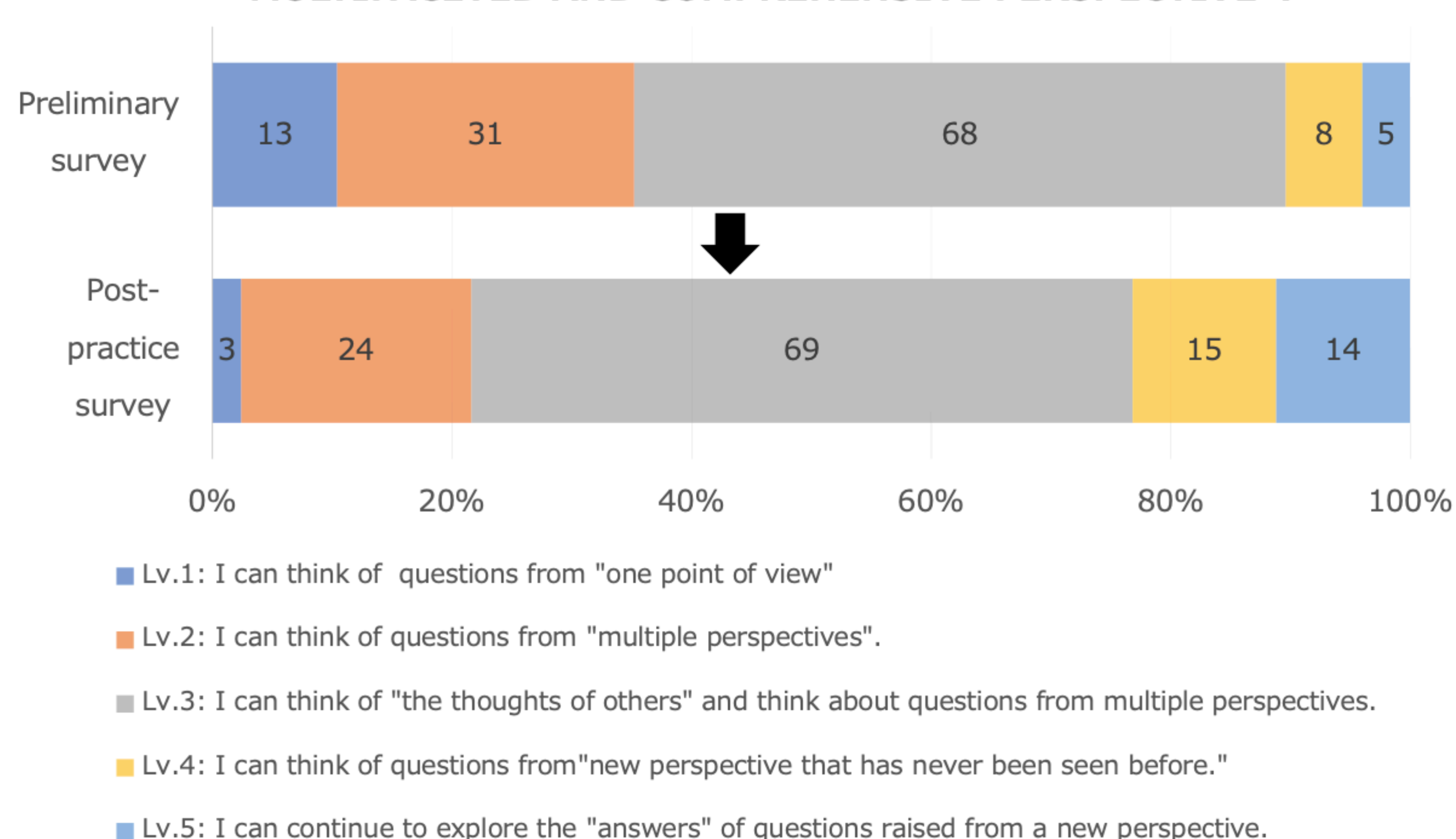

## [Contribution of this research in the context of distance education]

- Supporting teachers who had problems such as not being able to grasp the learning status of students and having no way to submit assignments due to the school closure measures by COVID-19.
- Supporting "remote collaborative learning" for students whose "interactive learning" is limited by spatial and physical distance constraints.
